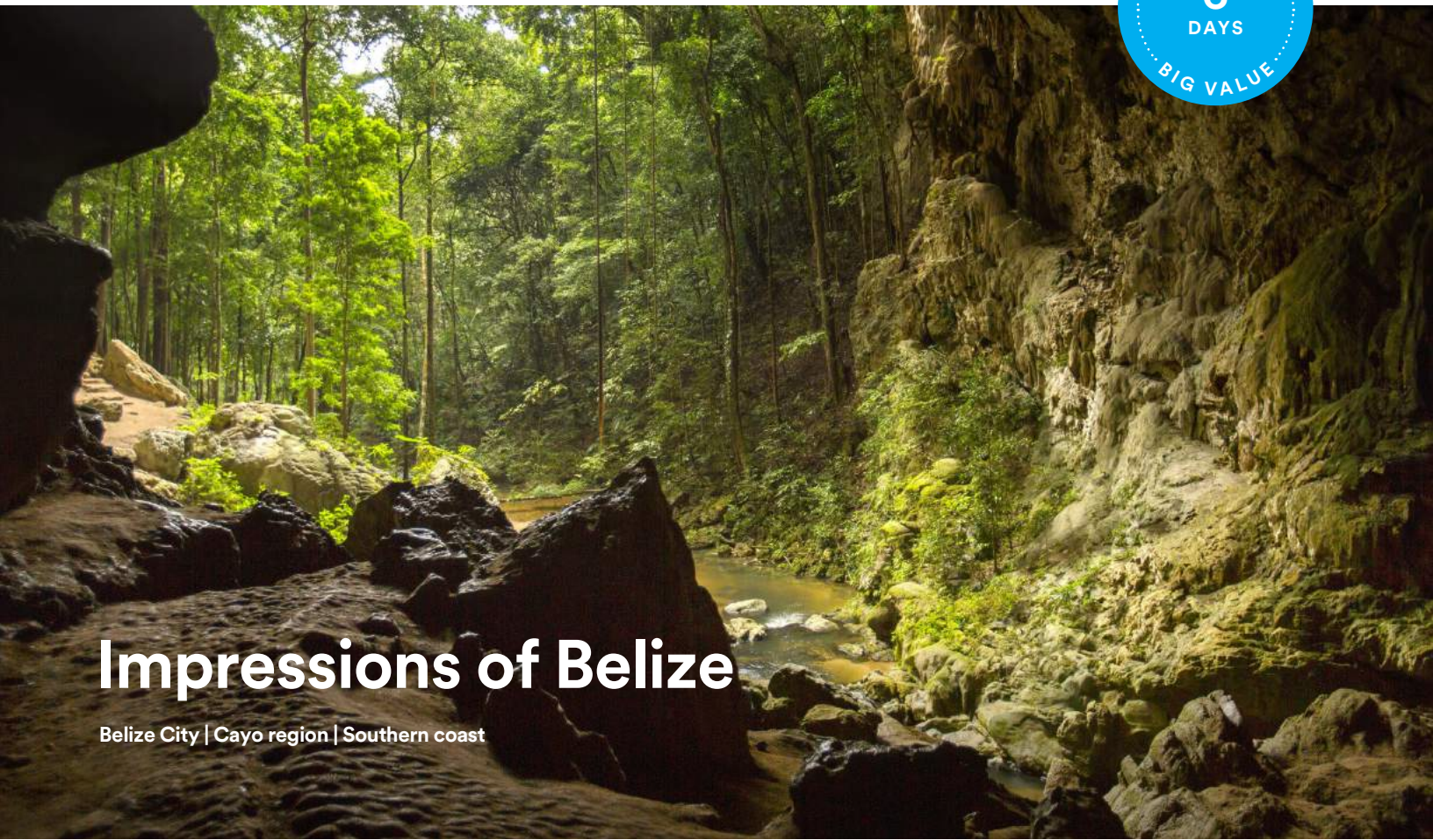

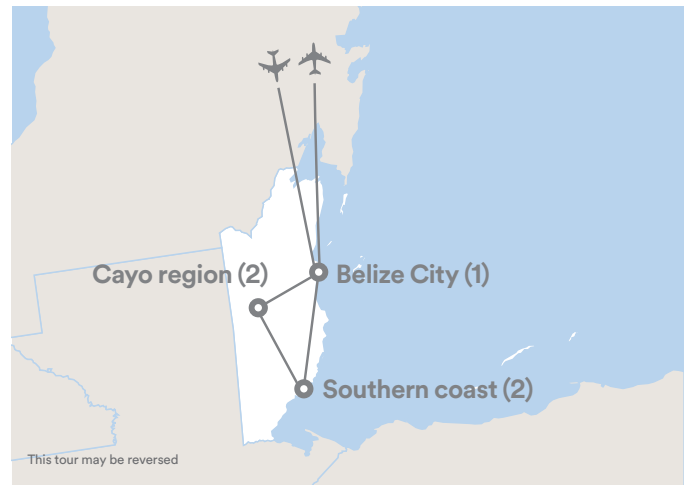

What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly to Belize

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Belize City.
- Travel to the Cayo region.

Day 2: Cayo region

- Enjoy a Maya cooking and pottery experience. Help make corn tortillas alongside local women, and try your hand at crafting traditional Maya pottery.
- Explore the Xunantunich Ruins, an archaeological site that features ancient Maya temples.

Day 3: Cayo region | Southern coast

- Travel to Belize's Southern coast.
- Experience the thrill of a ziplining adventure through the Belizean canopy. *(Participants must weigh less than 275 lbs.)*
- Discover tropical wildlife and float in tubes through hidden caves that contain remnants of sacrificial offerings from the Mayan era.

Day 4: Southern coast

- Go snorkeling in the nearby Cayes.
- Explore on your own or [enjoy a Garifuna drumming lesson.](#)

Day 5: Southern coast | Belize City

- Explore the process of small-scale manufacturing at a chocolate farm. Learn how the business supports local cacao growers, Maya communities, and sustainable agriculture through fine-tuned fermentation and drying techniques.
- Learn how one of Belize's top exports is grown and harvested at a visit to an organic farm.
- Continue on to Belize City.

Day 6: Depart for home

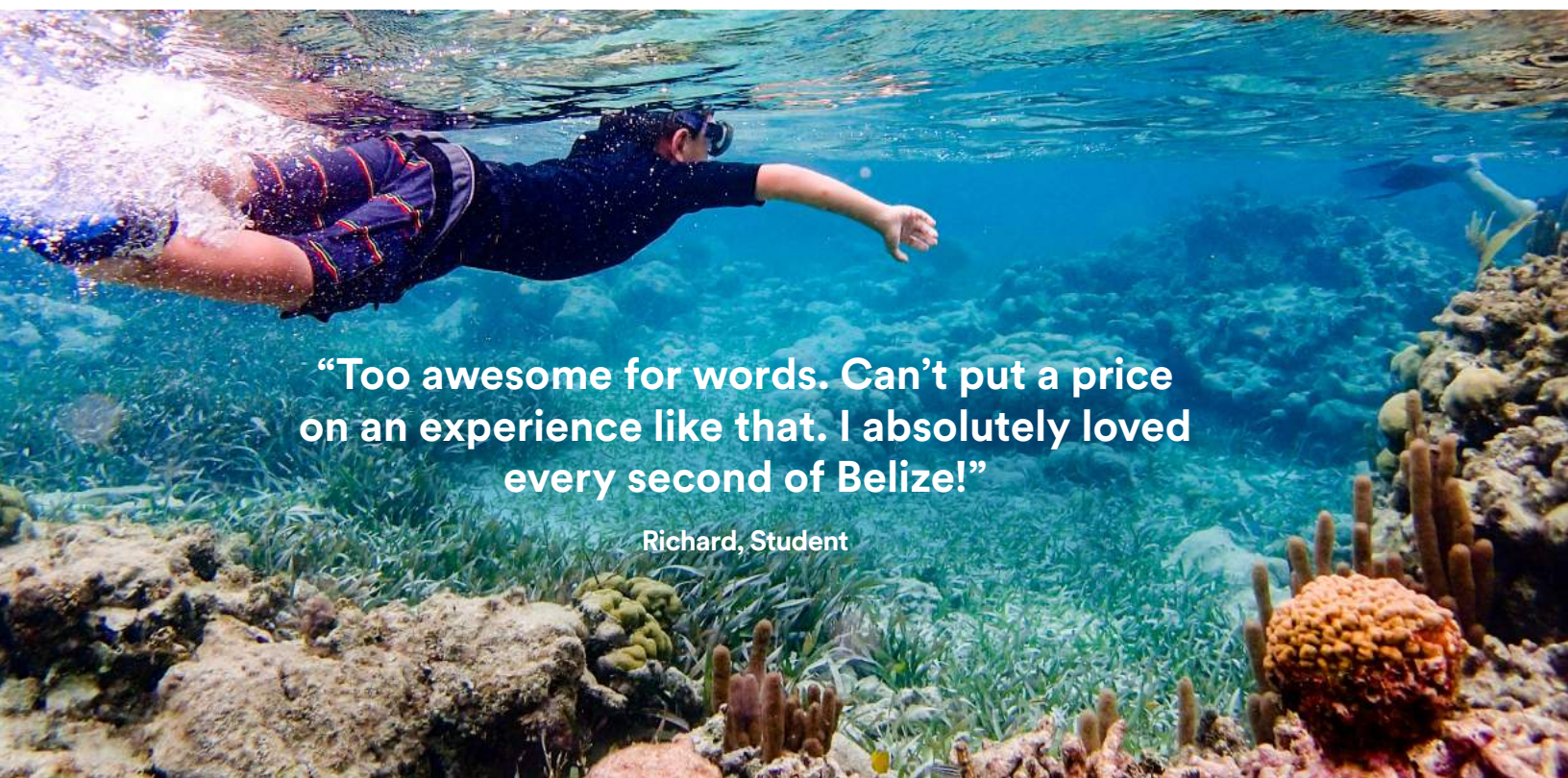
